# TERMS & CONDITIONS

## 1. Entry must be a two dimensional drawing or painting

The **maximum** dimensions of the art pieces that will be accepted are **50cm x 50cm**. Works can be any combination of length and size within these two maxima.

All the types of colour are acceptable (water-colour, acrylic, temperas, oil colours etc) Collage style drawings are not acceptable.

## 2. Theme: "Greece: Colour and Light"

## 3. One entry per student.

Each student may submit only one entry. No group entries are permitted.

## 4. How to Register.

Students interested in participating in the competition must **PRE- Register** by submitting a fully completed Registration Form or Registering online: Website details

A copy of a Registration Form is enclosed in this information pack but can be downloaded from website.

Registrations will open **August 13<sup>th</sup>** and close by **Friday October 15<sup>th</sup>** (hard copy forms must be received in the mail by October 15).

On registrations applicants will receive a **Receipt of Registration** with a **REGISTRATION CODE**. This Receipt of Registration **must accompany** the submitted works.

## 5. All submitted works must be accompanied by a signed Certificate of Authenticity.

A copy of a Certificate of Authenticity is enclosed in this information pack but can be downloaded from the website.

## 6. All submitted works must be 'framed'.

Framing can be as minima as possible, it is necessary to allow proper exhibition of the art work. On showing the Receipt of Registration – **Gallery 360** on Hay St, Subiaco will give a **40% discount on framing**.

## 7. Jackson's offer

On showing the Receipt of Registration – Jackson's Art Supplies will donate art supplies required to the value of \$X.00

### The Art Exhibition on Sunday October 31st.

The judging panel will be responsible for choosing the final 120 art works that will be displayed at the exhibition. All students will be notified in advance.

Art to be accepted in the competition must be delivered during the following days and times:

Friday 22 October, 4.00pm - 7.00pm

Saturday 23 October, 2.00pm -5.00pm

Sunday 24 October, 1.00pm -4.00pm

OR posted to 20 Parker St, Northbridge 6005 and received by Friday 22 October.



# ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

The following criteria will be taken in consideration in assessing students' work.

a. The student's age.

Category 1: Primary School Students: Years 4 to 7

Category 2: High School Students: Year 8 to 10

Category 3: High School Students: Year 11 & 12

b. **The originality of the work.** In case there is evidence of plagiarism or that someone else other than the student created the work, that entry will be automatically disqualified. Before disqualifying a particular entry there should be a proper investigation of the possibility of a student having a highly developed artistic talent.

c. Credit will be given to unusual figures or means of expression.

d. Credit will be given to innovative work as far as ideas are concerned, or towards discovering personal means of expression.

All entries will be assessed anonymously (numeric code as identifier) by our judging panel of : *Mr Arthur Spartalis, and three others*. All entries will be scored out of 100.

2<sup>nd</sup> Prize: \$300

**Category 3: High School Students: Year 11 to 12**
